Here the plural refers to principal men of the priesthood, including former high priests and, possibly, the heads of the 24 priestly divisions. scribes: This term originally referred to copyists of the Scriptures, but during Jesus' time, it referred to those who were experts in the Law and teachers of it. the Christ: Here the title "Christ" is preceded by the definite article in Greek, evidently as a way of emphasizing Jesus' office as the Messiah.
