More particularly: why would a man of his intellectual stature and ambition take the trouble to rehearse a few hackneyed truths and rules about the practice of translation? Let us look at what kind of a person Etienne Dolet was. 1 Life and Writings Etienne Dolet was born in Orléans in 1509 and died in Paris, at the Place Maubert, on 3 August 1546, on his 37th birthday. He was a Humanist, a learned man with excellent knowledge of both Latin and Greek. But the Encyclopedia Britannica entry on him also speaks of his "quarrelsome temperament" and his remarkable ability to make enemies. In the third book of *De institutione clericorum*, when he reorganized Augustine's analysis of classical education into the framework of the seven liberal arts, Hrabanus evoked Augustine's authority to drive a vibrant discussion of the renaissance of learning central to the project of the Carolingian renewal. Footnote 27 Thus, *De institutione clericorum* as a whole reflects more than just Hrabanus's. In his *Retractationes*, Augustine described *De doctrina christiana* as a handbook for preachers, a guide to learning truths and to teaching them. Footnote 32 He divided the work into four books. The first three consider exegetical questions, that is, what to get out of the Bible and how to do it. The first book considers the office of the pastor, particularly its difficulties and requirements. *Historia rerum ubique gestarum locorumque descriptio* is an unfinished book written by Enea Silvio Piccolomini, who was later elected Pope Pius II in 1458. It was written originally in Latin, and the title roughly translates to "History of Achievements Everywhere." The original intent of the book was to record the history of human existence across the globe, as well as a historical and geographical cosmography. Piccolomini planned three sections, on Europe, Asia, and Africa. Only the sections on Europe Since this Prologue is written in the first person, the narrator tells us a limited number of things we might not know otherwise, and perhaps things the characters themselves might not want others to know about them. Why is this time of year appropriate for a pilgrimage? Spring is the earliest time without hazardous weather, and spring is Easter time. What kind of information does our narrator, Chaucer, reveal about each pilgrim in turn? The narrator mentions the professions of the pilgrims, their places in society, and their attire. What has the narrator done to convince us, the readers, that In 1511 he composed his Ciceronian rhetorical manual *De copia verborum et rerum* ( *On Copia of Words and Ideas* ) and published his satirical *Moriae encomium* ( *Praise of Folly* ). These two works have much in common. *De copia* concerns the stylistic strategy of creating abundant variations on common ideas. *Praise of Folly* is a case in point: a book-length set of variations on the idea of folly. Of these three, Budé was most central to the development of French humanism, not only in his historical and philological studies but also in his use of his national influence to establish the Collège de France and the library at Fontainebleau. The influence of King Francis I and his learned sister Margaret of Angoulême was important in fostering the new learning.
