See More. Miscarriage of Justice. Jonathan Pollard was never charged with treason. [Legally, treason is a charge that is only applicable when one spies for an enemy state in time of war.] Jonathan Pollard was indicted on only one charge: one count of passing classified information to an ally, without intent to harm the United States. Prior to sentencing, then-Secretary of Defense Caspar Weinberger delivered a 46-page classified memorandum to the sentencing judge. In a dissenting opinion, Court of Appeals Judge Stephen Williams called the case "a fundamental miscarriage of justice," and wrote that he would have ordered that Pollard's sentence be vacated. In November 1995, Israel granted Jonathan Pollard Israeli citizenship. The official presentation took place in January of 1996.
